



2018 Workshare Instructions & Application

What is WorkShare?

- Workshare is a part of our Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) program
- Participants volunteer **6 hours each week**, for **20 weeks (May 29–October 12)**, to help prepare CSAs **Mondays-Thursdays between 8:00 am–5:00 pm**
- In exchange for 6 hours of work, participants receive weekly CSA shares of fresh produce from our organic urban farm
- CSA prep work includes harvesting, washing/packing, cleaning and CSA distribution
- CSAs are available for pick-up upon completion of 6 hours of volunteering each week

Am I Eligible?

- Eligibility is based on referrals from Continuum of Care organizations **OR** self-identified financial need
- Workshare participants must attend a workshare orientation at the farm prior to starting (to be scheduled upon approval)
- Participants can share workshare responsibilities with another person; be sure to list them on your application

- Riverview Gardens staff will contact you to approve and schedule an orientation
